SUBJECT: 2018 Statement of Economic Interests Notice and E-Filing System

Based on your position with the County of San Mateo, you are required to file an annual Statement of Economic Interests (Form 700) by April 2, 2018. Except for deadlines that fall on Saturday, Sunday or an official state holiday, there is no provision in the law for an extension of a filing deadline. Late statements are subject to a \$10 per day late fine.

In an effort to simplify and expedite the filing procedure, the County of San Mateo will use the NetFile paperless filing system to electronically file the Form 700. Online filing is available 24/7 from any computer with internet access. NetFile will save you time, ensure required data is complete, and eliminate the need for filing technical amendments. Moreover, all data is saved for future filings. You will not need to print, sign, or mail your Form 700.

Keep in mind that the County of San Mateo has received permission from the Fair Political Practices Commission (FPPC) to receive an e-filing as the filing of record. This means that an original, wet-signed paper copy is no longer required when you file through NetFile. Once you e-file, you are finished!

WHEN TO FILE: No later than Monday, April 2, 2018

HOW TO FILE: Go to the NetFile Log-in Page at https://netfile.com/filer to file your statement electronically.

To receive a Password:

- New Users Click the "New User? Request a Password" link in the Form 700 (SEI) Filers section of the
 page. Submit your e-mail address to receive an e-mail from NetFile containing a link. Click the link to
 view your password. Make sure to record the password. You may change the password once you log in.
- Existing Users If you need a new password, click the "Lost Your Password?" link below the password field. Submit your e-mail address to receive an e-mail from NetFile containing a link. Click the link to view your password. Make sure to record the password. You may change the password once you log in.

Important Notes about your filing:

- After you log in, click the "Get Help for this Page" button for information and instructions. Each page also
 includes links to short instructional videos. At the end of the process, you can create a draft document for
 review. When you are satisfied with the document, please e-file your document by clicking on the "E-File
 Statement" button. You do not have to print, sign and submit a paper copy when you e-file through your
 NetFile account.
- All Form 700s are public record. You are encouraged to list your business (not home) address on the cover page.
- This annual filing covers the prior (2017) calendar year.
- Bookmark the following link to access your NetFile account anytime: https://netfile.com/filer.
- Your information will be saved securely in your account to make future filings easier.

WHAT TO FILE: Your disclosure categories will be displayed upon logging into your user account.

NOTHING TO DISCLOSE? File in a flash through the NetFile app (only for filers with nothing to disclose). For an iPhone or iPad, download the app from iTunes. For an Android phone or tablet, download the app from Google Play. Visit https://netfile.com/content/mobileapps for direct links to download the application and further information about using NetFile's mobile application on Android and Apple devices.

LATE FILINGS: Please be aware that your annual filing is due on April 2, 2018. There is no provision in the law for an extension of a filing deadline. Late statements are subject to a \$10 per day fine, up to a maximum of \$100, in addition to fines imposed by the Fair Political Practices Commission (FPPC).
